Where do the words come from?

I found a list of English words to use – [this one](#). Then I made two lists – `first_names.txt` and `last_names.txt` based on the following criteria:

First name (end result: 16692 words):

- starts with "B"
- is at least 6 letters long
- is not Benedict

Last name (end result: 28786 words):

- starts with "C" or "K"
- is at least 6 letters long
- does not start with "ch"
- is not Cumberbatch, though it wasn't in the dataset anyway
